

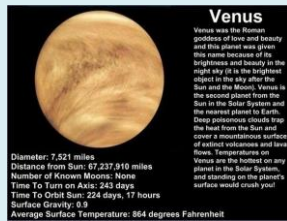
## Class 2 Homework - To Infinity and Beyond

Homework is due in every fortnight. All children should complete the literacy and numeracy tasks and then they may choose from the remaining subjects what else they would like to do. However, children are most welcome to do more than what is set if they wish. Please bring completed homework to school on the following Monday mornings: 15<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> January and 12<sup>th</sup> February.

Please read with your child daily at home, little & often is best and also practise weekly spelling sentence/s. The number bonds and times table passports are ongoing pieces of homework to be practised regularly over the terms ahead.

### 1. Literacy

Find out some facts about your home table planet and present them on a poster for our display. Include a question in your poster to draw the reader in.



### 3. Geography

Identify and label features on the attached map. You may draw lines to the features or create a key.

### 2. Numeracy

Counting down to blast off!

Practise counting backwards;

- steps of 1 from any number up to 100 - from how great a number can you count down from?
- steps of 10 from 120
- steps of 2 from 24
- steps of 5 from 60

Present your counting down on a space theme. For example; all the numbers written on a planet, star or from the top to the bottom of a rocket.

### 4. History

Interview a relative or family friend who can remember the first moon landing in 1969. Think of two or three questions you can ask them and write down their answers to share with the class.
