


COMPTON ALL SAINTS' C OF E PRIMARY SCHOOL


- For more information about your child/ren's progress;

As a result we have introduced the progress and attainment slips that you are given at the March parent consultations. These use assessment data to give you information about how well your child is doing in comparison to national standards and specific areas in which they need support. We also produced a homework document (on the website) that gives clear information about what is expected of each class of children.

The second survey will come in a couple of weeks' time and will focus on ways in which we can improve the budgetary situation for the school, including by generating more income.

Both surveys are really important for us so I do hope you will be able to find the time to complete them.
