

## Class 2 Homework - Handa's Surprise

Homework is due in every fortnight. All children should complete the literacy and numeracy tasks and then they may choose from the remaining subjects what else they would like to do. Please bring completed homework to school on the following Monday mornings: 11<sup>th</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup> June and 9<sup>th</sup> July.

**Please read with your child daily at home, little & often is best.** Your child will also need to practise their weekly spelling words and sentence.

### 1. Literacy/Science

Uganda is often described as Africa's Fruit Basket. Can you find out about a fruit that grows and is farmed in Uganda? What does it look like as it is growing? Is it from a bush or a tree? Maybe you could buy some and try it!

Make an information poster to show what you found out. Remember: a clear title, photos/drawings, captions, descriptive vocabulary, interesting facts & your taste test results if you try a new fruit.

### 2. Numeracy

Write word problems for the class to solve e.g.

There are 20 mangoes in the shop. 11 are sold. How many mangoes are left?

There are 5 bananas in each bunch and 6 bunches in total. How many bananas altogether? Or how many bunches will I need to give 22 children a banana each?

Year 1 to do one addition and one subtraction problem. Year 2 to write an addition, subtraction, multiplication and division problem.

### 3. Science

Grow something from seed and document its growth with annotated drawings or photographs.



### 4. Geography

Find out some interesting facts about Africa or Uganda to share with the class. Write them on the attached map in your best handwriting. Make sure the letters are large enough so we can read it from our homework display.
